

# Using Full Text Finder on Database Searches

1. To use Full Text Finder (FTF), start with a search on any of our databases (Academic Search Complete, CBCA Complete, etc.). Databases can be accessed from here: <http://www.yukoncollege.yk.ca/library/pages/articles>
2. Click the Full Text Finder link whenever there is no PDF or HTML options available for an article.
